2nd CALL FOR PAPERS

The IARPP Annual Conference, “*Changing Psychoanalysis for a Changing Society: Relational Perspectives*”, will be held in Madrid, Spain, from Wednesday, June 29 through Saturday, July 2, 2011.

We welcome all IARPP Members to submit abstracts for paper and/or panel proposals that address conference themes. The conference will feature plenary panels, paper presentations, and interdisciplinary conversations with an emphasis on clinical and social intervention. Audience participation and discussion will be encouraged by a format that calls for short papers followed by conversations with interlocutors and audience members rather than formal discussants. An interactive poster session will be also developed (see the web page).

Abstracts for individual papers and panel presentations are welcomed. New speakers for IARPP conferences are also welcomed and encouraged. Paper sessions are scheduled for 90 minutes total, including 20 minute paper presentations and 15-minute responses from interlocutors, followed by audience discussion. Interlocutors will be assigned to paper sessions, however submissions of papers that are paired as a panel may suggest an interlocutor on the attached Cover Sheet. It is acceptable to the organizers that someone who wishes to speak in language other than English brings a personal translator or a translation with them - but be careful to observe time boundaries. English translation of the whole intervention must be provided to organizers before March 30, 2011.

***** ABSTRACT SUBMISSION PROCESS *****

The **deadline for receipt of abstracts is Thursday, December 30, 2010. No names should appear on your abstract** as reviews of submissions are anonymous. You must submit your presentation through the online webform (see www.iarpp2011.com) which will open September 10, 2010. Please be sure to include 2 Educational Objectives, the title of your proposed paper and, when it is paired with another paper, the title of your panel with a detailed, one paragraph Abstract.

Please submit the following materials in English language:

- 1. Send proposal via our Online Webform** at www.iarpp2011.com
- Including **Title**, one paragraph **Abstract** (up to 500 words) and **2 Educational Objectives** for your presentation [*“At the conclusion of my presentation, the participant will be able to: (describe, explain, illustrate...)”*].
- A Brief **Curriculum Vitae** (no more than 2 pages) must be attached.

Due to accreditation application requirements, all of these materials must be submitted in order for your submission to be reviewed. We regret that presentations submitted *without* all of the above items *cannot be considered* for review. All submissions will be reviewed by the Program Committee. Authors will be notified of the Committee’s decision by February 2011. Acceptance is limited by space availability.
